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You are hereby notified that the Court has issued the following order:

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No. 2023AP1399-OA      Clarke v. Wisconsin Elections Commission

On January 12, 2024, the court received a document titled “Joint Stipulation as to Confidentiality of Legislative Technology Services Bureau Shapefile with Incumbent Addresses.” The stipulation states that it is entered into by all parties other than the Wisconsin Elections Commission and its individual Commissioners and Administrator. The stipulation further states that certain files contained within the digital data submitted by the Legislature and the Republican Senator respondents, Senator Rachael Cabral-Guevara et al., in support of their proposed remedial maps, on January 12, 2024, contain “personal identifying information that, if disclosed in the form provided, may cause harassment.” According to the stipulation, the files at issue are named “Incumbents\_WI\_Legislature\_2024\_01\_05.”

The court hereby construes the parties’ stipulation as, in part, a joint motion asking the court to seal the digital files at issue in the record of this case. Based on the representations made in the stipulation,

IT IS ORDERED that the motion is granted. The clerk of this court shall place the electronic storage device filed by the Legislature and Senator Rachael Cabral-Guevara et al. on January 12, 2024, under seal; and

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Legislature and Senator Rachael Cabral-Guevara et al. shall file, within seven calendar days of the date of this order, an electronic storage device containing all of the digital data filed by the Legislature on January 12, 2024, with the exception of those files named “Incumbents\_WI\_Legislature\_2024\_01\_05.” The clerk of this court shall place this electronic storage device into the public file.
